Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Well, here we are again. Another trek through Lent has brought us to the threshold of the holiest days of the entire year. While Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday are not technically holy days of obligation, they are most certainly THE holiest days of all, as they provide us the opportunity to retrace the way of our salvation accomplished in the person of Jesus of Nazareth. As we gather each day – first for the Mass of the Lord’s Supper on the evening of Holy Thursday, as Lent gives way to the Sacred Paschal Triduum; and then for the Celebration of the Passion of the Lord on Good Friday; and then for the Mass of Vigil in the holy night of Easter – we are not just hearing the story of Jesus’ example of service, His Passion, Death, and Resurrection, we are hearing OUR story, for what we mark these three sacred days is the very reason for our hope against hope!

Please, please don’t let the most sacred of days pass by as if they’re merely April 13, 14, 15 and 16. Even if you’re away from home for spring break, please find a Catholic Church in your area, and participate in these rituals that are at the very core of our Catholic Christian faith. I ask particularly that you consider participating in the Mass of Vigil on Holy Saturday. It is the most important, most beautiful, most powerful liturgy of the entire year, and it is the night that we will welcome new Catholic Christians to the Church and to our parish through the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. Yes, it is a long Mass (about two and a half hours in length) because it traces the working of God on our behalf throughout Salvation History, and then we see His saving power at work – before our eyes – as Gayle and Harry will step into the baptismal font, die to their old ways of living, and become a new creation in Christ Jesus right before our very eyes. Please, if you can, be here to welcome them on this most holy of days in their lives as our parish is changed by their coming into it.

Finally, our parish has offered Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament on Tuesdays and Fridays into Saturday morning for many years now. We are looking at implementing some minor changes to our customs since reviewing the Church documents that govern this ritual, and having pondered how to best put those directives into practice at Saint Mike’s. Meanwhile, we want to invite those who have not had the opportunity in the past to sign up for an hour before the Lord Jesus present in the monstrance to do so. Therefore, you’ll see schedules listing all of the available hour-long time slots on Tuesdays, Fridays, and Saturday mornings in the back of

both churches over the next couple weeks. Our goal is to have at least two individuals or families signed up for each time slot so that we’re assured the Lord Jesus is never left alone during those times of Exposition. Please consider how you can deepen your friendship with the Lord by your four-month-long commitment that would begin in May and continue through August. We’ll have another sign-up opportunity then.

I hope and pray that these coming days are wonderful opportunities for reflection and renewal as we journey with the Lord Jesus through death to life in Him.
